
To make your experience even better, we will be offering:

In addition to exciting new food and wine offerings, we are working to streamline your access to the concert Amphitheatre. To help expedite this process and provide thorough security checks for everyone's safety, we've updated the items you can and cannot bring into the concert Amphitheatre.

To continue to deliver a remarkable experience, the below items are no longer accepted:

- Rolling items used for hauling, such as wagons, carts, & coolers with wheels
- Hard-shelled coolers (*Soft-sided hand-carried insulated coolers are still allowed*)
- Duffel bags, luggage, or industrial/camping-sized back packs (*Tote bags, purses and standard backpacks are still allowed*)
- Canopies or tents
- Tables longer than 3ft wide and 2ft high (*Tables smaller than this are still allowed*)
