

# 2016 HIGHLIGHTS

Hosted by Chateau Ste. Michelle & Dr. Loosen Estate



Winemakers from seven countries converged at Chateau Ste. Michelle winery and Bell Harbor International Conference Center in Seattle, Washington July 17–19, 2016 for the fifth Riesling Rendezvous. Hosted by Chateau Ste. Michelle of Washington and Dr. Loosen of Germany, Riesling Rendezvous featured wineries from Australia, Austria, Canada, France, Germany, New Zealand, California, Idaho, Michigan, New York, Oregon, and Washington.

Riesling Rendezvous is the largest event dedicated to Riesling in the United States. Riesling Rendezvous first emerged from Chateau Ste. Michelle and Dr. Loosen's commitment to promote the extraordinary nature of Riesling. It is designed to bring together leading experts and producers to explore the versatility of Rieslings from around the world, discuss issues and opportunities surrounding the advancement of Riesling, and forge alliances among producers and Riesling enthusiasts.

More than 700 Riesling enthusiasts attended the Grand Tasting at Chateau Ste. Michelle on July 17th to taste the finest Rieslings from around the globe and experience the diversity of this varietal from each region. Guests also sampled an array of Riesling-friendly food from popular Seattle food trucks Barking Frog, Jemil Caters and Snout & Co., along with appetizers prepared by Chateau Ste. Michelle's Executive Chef Janet Hedstrom and culinary staff.

Trade tastings on July 18th & 19th were held at the Bell Harbor International Conference Center in Seattle and featured in-depth blind tastings and seminars led by distinguished speakers and producers on topics such as: The State of Riesling: Climatic Trends, Current Growing Conditions and Future Projections; Discovering the Diversity of Australian Riesling; The Essential Elements of Dry Riesling; Tips from the Pros on Selling Riesling; and Rocks & Riesling: Alsace's Diverse Terroir.
