Registration and login

In order to be able to use certain services of our Platform, you need to first register an account with us, where you are able to determine your personal login credentials that you need to be able to log into your personal account. For this registration and subsequent login procedure, we collect the following information about you:

- Display Name
- Email adress
- Given name
- Surname

We process this personal data in order to provide you with an access to the services of our Platform. They are deleted in case you deactivate your user account.

Setting of cookies

What are cookies?

This Platform uses so-called "cookies". Cookies are small text files that are stored in the memory of your terminal via your browser. What cookies do we use?
