THIS UNIQUE HEIRLOOM VARIETY, WAS GROWN BY THE KOZACK FAMILY, THIRD-GENERATION ALBERTA BARLEY GROWERS IN THE CLEAR HILLS OF NORTHERN ALBERTA.

THE KOZACK FAMILY HOMESTEADED THEIR FARM IN 1932 AND HAVE BEEN PRODUCING OLLI SINCE IT WAS RELEASED IN THE 1930'S. IN 1973, MIKE KOZACK PURCHASED THE LAST AVAILABLE SEED AND THEIR FAMILY HAS CONTINUED TO GROW OLLI AS IT IS WELL SUITED FOR THE CLIMATE OF THE CLEAR HILLS
